Requirements:

The student must meet criteria item 1 and demonstrate fulfillment at least 4 of the criteria described in items 2 through 6 below in order to be eligible for consideration for this scholarship:

Criteria:		Example for Demonstrating Criteria:	
1.	Must successfully completed the first year of medical education.	Supply an unofficial transcript showing completion of M1 year at CNUCOM with passing grades.	
2.	Demonstrates a documented need for financial assistance.	Supply documentation about income, assets, and personal history of applying for loans and/or need to work to make ends meet while in school.	
3.	Demonstrates effort in seeking available financial aid avenues (e.g. applying for loan programs or U.S. Armed Services Health Professions Scholarship Program).	Supply documentation of personal financial hardship showing that current, outstanding loan balance is near one's loan ceiling or loan limit or borrowing from multiple sources; submit documented application of loans or scholarship programs.	
4.	Demonstrates significant contribution to the wellness of the College/university and communicates responsibly in ways that demonstrate a commitment to the ideals and betterment of the College/university. Supply documentation of events/activities or communicates, etc. that describe your participation in resulting a positive effect in College or University events, yearbook, community service involvement/activities, student research, student government leaders, interview student ambassador, etc.	Supply documentation of events/activities or communicates etc. that describe your participation in resulting a positive effect in school events, community service involvement/activities, student research, student government leaders, interview student ambassador, etc.	
5.	Demonstrates a genuine financial obligation to sustain family.	Supply documentation for supporting and raising a child/family, e.g., tax return.	
6.	Demonstrates acceptable academic progress to meet graduation requirements.	Demonstrates good academic standing and on track to graduate on time as defined by COM Student Handbook by supplying an unofficial transcript.
