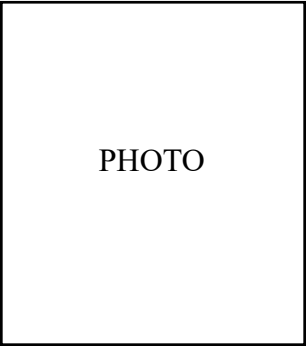

- A/ Completed application form.
- B/ The essay.
- C/ A personal statement of 600 words or less about yourself and your future plan.
- D/ A financial award letter or statement from the financial aid office of your medical school.
- E/ Your 1040 tax return for 2023(or 2022 if 2023 return not yet available) or your parents' 1040 if you are a dependent. If there was no 1040 filed, please write a statement about such fact.
- F/ Two letters of recommendation in support of your research and/or community services.
- G/ Other items to support your application..
