Position Description: California Northstate University College of Health Sciences seeks excellent teaching faculty for part-time instruction in Service-Learning for Health Care Professionals (COLL 420) for the Spring 2019 semester.

Job Classification: FTE as assigned, part-time

Review of Applications: Applications are reviewed as received. For best consideration, apply before November 15, 2018.

Education and Experience: A master's degree in a relevant field is the minimum requirement although a doctorate is preferred. Teaching experience in the subject area is highly desired. Experience living and/or working in underserved communities OR community service/work experience with non-profit or governmental agencies serving marginalized communities is required. Candidates must have experience facilitating social justice and diversity inclusion workshop, classes, or the equivalent. Preferred qualifications include 1) knowledge of service-learning pedagogy with a focus on issues of inequity and social justice and 2) experience in community-based, project-based and/or experiential education are preferred.

Successful candidates must be committed to working with diverse student and community populations, including non-profit, governmental, and educational institutions. Salary is dependent upon qualifications and relevant experience. Official university transcripts may be required upon hire.

Job Description: Part-time faculty are expected to maintain the highest standard of classroom teaching excellence, adhere to college policy, and hold regular office hours for student assistance. Part-time faculty may also be asked to attend regular meetings with course lead faculty to maintain alignment with institutional and course learning outcomes.
