

Cost of Attendance and Tuition and Fees

Payment of Tuition and Fees

All tuition and fees for each semester are due and payable 10 days prior to the first official day of class with the exception of new incoming students. For all new incoming students, please follow the payment due dates on the last page of your enrollment agreement.

Living Expense Checks

Living Expense Checks are usually ready for pick up after add/drop period after the semester (Fall or Spring) has started.

For students who will be receiving Living Expense checks from your private educational loans, the Business Office will send an email notification when checks are ready for pick up.
