Ms. Susan Bonilla is the Chief Executive Officer for the California Pharmacists Association (CPhA) and is focused on advocating for our members and the profession at the California State Capitol and at the Board of Pharmacy. She has spent most of her life in public service, first serving her community as a high school English teacher and then transitioning into elected office. Susan served as a Council Member and Mayor of the City of Concord, and as a Contra Costa County Supervisor. This experience led to her election to the California State Assembly where she served for six years both on the Health Committee and as the Chair of Business, Professions and Consumer Protection Committee. Her introduction to pharmacy came about when S.B. 493, the bill granting health care provider status to pharmacists, was passed by the Business and Professions Committee and signed into law. Leading CPhA in the continued implementation of health care provider status and in promoting the role of the pharmacist, while providing valuable resources and a vibrant community to members, is her passion. She holds a Bachelors in English from Azusa Pacific University and a Masters in Educational Leadership from Concordia University.

Dr. Satinder Sandhu serves as Walgreen's Health Care Supervisor for Pharmacy and Retail Operations in the Northern California area. In his current role, Dr. Sandhu oversees clinical and quality initiatives at Walgreens and provides operational support to the district managers in the area. He has helped expand the role of pharmacy technicians by overseeing technician immunization training and Covid-19 testing programs for Walgreens in California and Hawaii. He also helped increase the delivery of vaccinations to underserved communities by partnering with the Department of Public Health in both San Francisco and Sacramento to deliver Covid-19 vaccines to underserved populations and long-term care facilities. As a district leader for Walgreens, he helped pharmacists establish outreach clinics at senior centers and assisted-living facilities where they counseled seniors on their medications. As a community pharmacist, he helped lobby at the state level for access to clean needles. He also lobbied for expanding the scope of practice for pharmacists at the state and federal level by attending California Pharmacy Legislative Day in Sacramento and RxIMPACT Day on Capitol Hill.

Dr. Sandhu is passionate about supporting pharmacists in all stages of their careers and improving healthcare outcomes for patients from all walks of life. He has served as a preceptor, advisor, and mentor for pharmacy students at California Northstate University during their community outreach projects.
